Upcycled Wall Clock

Here is an easy upcycle from Jez. Even your old Evolution blade doesn't get wasted.



Materials & Tools

- Your old Evolution blade (blunt and safe).
- 1x clock mechanism kit.
- 1x M8 repair washer (large washer).
- Appropriate spanner/wrench.



Step 1

Place the rubber washer that comes with kit over the spindle of the clock mechanism and then place the old blade on top of that making sure to centre it on the spindle.



Step 2

Place the repair washer, then the small washer from the kit over the spindle and then wind on the nut, making sure everything stays central.



Step 3

Nip the nut, but do not over tighten.



Step 4

Fit the hands starting with the hour, then minute and finally the second hand. After the hands are fitted, wind the hands round using the time adjuster to make sure the hands do not clash, if they do; gently bend them until they are clear of each other.

Step 5

Finally put a battery in, set the time and hang your new clock on your workshop wall.

Note.

Clock mechanisms can be purchased from eBay or you can upcycle from an old clock.
