Upcycled Coffee Table

Jez Armstrong, a professional upcycler produces a contemporary and creative coffee table from scaffold board and scaffold tube. **Check out the video by Jez showing you the simple steps to creating this coffee table.**



Materials & Tools

- 2x 720mm scaffold board or similar
- 2x 280mm support timber eg. 25 x 50
- Scaffold tube 4x 615mm
- Scaffold tube 2x 330mm
- Scaffold tube 2x 280mm
- 8x kee klamp 90* elbows (can be found on eBay)
- 4x 80mm screw
- 8x 50mm screw
- Evolution RAGE2 355mm Chop Saw
- Evolution Mini Belt Sander

Step 2

Assemble the tube as seen in the pictures and video. 615mm long, 280 wide and 330 high, the over all size of the frame will be bigger when taking into account the joints.



Step 1

Cut the boards and tubes to the required size.





Step 3

Lay the two pieces of 720mm board side by side and mark 100mm in from both ends. Mark the centre of the 280mm support timber. Then place the support on the marks, pilot and screw with the 8x 50mm screws.

Step 4

Now would be a good time to put your finish on eg. Varnish, wax or oil onto your top and maybe a coat of lacquer onto the frame.



Step 5

In the two top tubes of the frame drill two 5.5mm holes in each tube, 25-30mm in from the joint (4 holes in total).



Step 6

Place the top onto the frame and through the pre-drilled holes using the 80mm screws secure the top to the frame.

Step 7

Sit back and enjoy your new table.

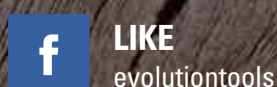
