Materials & Tools

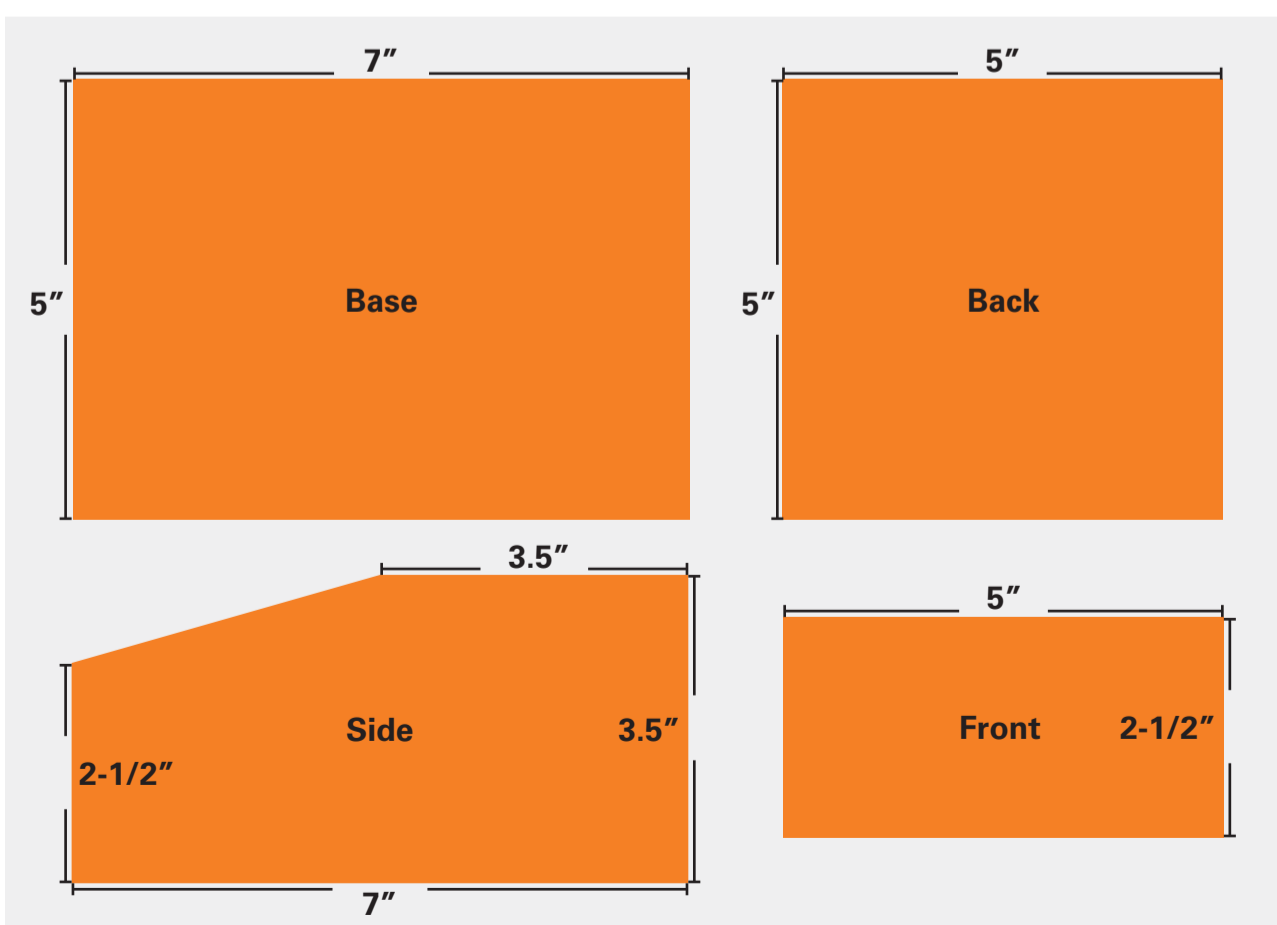
- Chipboard
- RAGE5 Multipurpose Table Saw
- RAGE3-S Multipurpose Sliding Mitre Saw
- Nails
- Glue



Step 1

**Storage boxes for my screws.
All made out of chipboard.**

I cut down to size with my Evolution RAGE5 255mm TCT Multipurpose Table Saw.





Step 2

Cut a 30% angle on the sides with my Evolution RAGE3-S 210mm TCT Multipurpose Sliding Mitre Saw.



Step 3

Glue the chipboard together.



Step 4

French Cleat

On the back of the boxes you can use french cleating to hang the boxes on a wall. As shown.

Repeat the steps above to make more.
